## THE STATS

20.6 % of New Yorkers live below poverty level, 50% of those below the poverty level are employed but still not making enough to support themselves and their family.

"A record 60,000 homeless New Yorkers, including more than 25,000 children, sleep in shelters each night. During the last fiscal year, one in 42 children slept in the homeless shelter system, including one of every 17 African American children and one of every 34 Latino children." (NY Daily News)

## OUR IMPACT: THE NUMBERS

This year alone, we have distributed over One Million Pounds (1,000,000 lbs.) of food to people in need.



**We have supplied food to over 120,000 individuals in need through our Food Pantry.**



**We have impacted on the lives of over 2,000 people in need in Third World countries through our Medical Missions.**



**We have assisted over 600 persons affected by disasters through our Disaster Relief Program**



**We have provided toys and school supplies to over 1000 children through our Back to School Giveaways and Children Christmas Party.**



**We have distributed over 1,000 coats through our Annual Coat Drive.**



**We have provided food, school supplies and baby clothes for over 700 people living in homeless shelters.**

We have also provided free tax services to over 100 people and SNAP (Food Stamp) & Other Referral Services to over 500 persons.

The numbers do not lie. PHC has had an extremely positive impact on this community since its inception. We can do so much more but the resources are limited.
